Georgia Executive Branch

Governor Brian P. Kemp



Brian P. Kemp is the 83rd Governor of Georgia who took office in January 2019. His political career began when he served as a state senator from 2003 – 2007. Prior to becoming Governor he served as Georgia's Secretary of State from 2010 – 2018. He is a business owner, entrepreneur and investor. His wife Marty and their three daughters reside in the Athens, Georgia area.

At the beginning of the 2021 – 2022, Governor Kemp expressed his support for legislation that would extend income tax exemption to military retirees who reside in the state. In the Spring of 2022 he was honored to sign into law House Bill 1064, which provides an income tax exemption of \$17,500 per year for military retirees from the time of their military retirement until 62 years of age. At 62 years of age, existing law provides for an exemption of \$35,000 and then at age 65 the exemption rises to \$65,000.

The combined effect of these income tax exemptions will encourage military retirees to live in Georgia and become productive members of our workforce, instead of moving to other states that exempt all or part of income from state taxes.

Georgia House of Representatives

Representative Jesse Petrea



State Representative Jesse Petrea serves the citizens of House District 166, which includes the eastern parts of Chatham and Bryan counties. He is currently the chairman of the House Human Resources and Aging Committee and a member of the Appropriations, Health and Human Services, Public Safety and Homeland Security, Science and Technology and the Game fish and Parks committees. He is the vice president of development for Help at Home and has been involved for many years in community-based services to the frail elderly and developmentally disabled industry. He and his wife are natives of Savannah and have two children and three grandchildren.

As a member of the House Appropriations Committee, Representative took the leadership role of sponsor of House Bill 1064 and shepherded the legislation in the House of Representatives that provides an income tax exemption of \$17,500 per year for military retirees from the time of their military retirement until 62 years of age. At 62 years of age, existing law provides for an exemption of \$35,000 and then at age 65 the exemption rises to \$65,000.

The combined effect of these income tax exemptions will encourage military retirees to live in Georgia and become productive members of our workforce, instead of moving to other states that exempt all or part of income from state taxes.

Georgia Senate

Senator Kay Kirkpatrick, M.D.



State Senator Kay Kirkpatrick, M.D., represents Senate District 32, which includes East Cobb and Sandy Springs. She is the Chairman of the Veterans, Military and Homeland Security Committee, a member of the Appropriations Committee, Health and Human Services, Insurance and Labor, and the Judiciary committees. She is a member of the Georgia Joint Defense Commission and is a legislative liaison to the Commission on the Holocaust. She has been an orthopaedic hand surgeon in Atlanta for over 30 years and was previously the President of Resurgens Orthopaedics a large orthopaedic surgery practice in the greater Atlanta area. She and her husband, Dr. Tom Haltom who is an emergency physician, have two children and reside in East Cobb County, Georgia.

As Chairman of the Senate Veterans, Military and Homeland Security Committee, she took the role of sponsor in the Senate of House Bill 1064 and shepherded it in the Senate that provides an income tax exemption of \$17,500 per year for military retirees from the time of their military retirement until 62 years of age. At 62 years of age, existing law provides for an exemption of \$35,000 and then at age 65 the exemption rises to \$65,000.

The combined effect of these income tax exemptions will encourage military retirees to live in Georgia and become productive members of our workforce, instead of moving to other states that exempt all or part of income from state taxes.



Vince Dooley
The University of Georgia
Head Football Coach, 1964-88
Director of Athletics, 1979-2004

For over 50 years now, Dooley has had an enduring impact on the University of Georgia, the Southeastern Conference, and college athletics across the country. Serving as head football coach at UGA from 1963 to 1989 and as director of athletics from 1979 to 2004. He was recognized in 2019 with the naming of Dooley Field at Sanford Stadium in his honor. Earlier His contributions to the University were recognized in 2008 with the dedication of the Vince Dooley Athletic Complex on Nov. 29, 2008. A statue and garden commemorate his accomplishments along with the naming of all the south campus athletic facilities in his honor.

Dooley is the only person ever to hold the presidency of both the American Football Coaches Association and the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics—a testament to his contributions to coaching and athletics administration.

Dooley was named NCAA National Coach of the Year by every major poll in 1980 and by Chevrolet-WTBS in 1982. He was named SEC Coach of the Year seven times and NCAA District Coach of the Year on six occasions. He holds the unique distinction of being inducted into the Sports Hall of Fame in two different states: Georgia and Alabama. Dooley is a 1978 inductee into the State of Georgia Sports Hall of Fame and a 1994 inductee into the National College Football Hall of Fame. In 2001, he received the Amos Alonzo Stagg Award from the American Football Coaches Association for lifetime contributions to the sport of football. He was inducted into the UGA Circle of Honor in 2004 and the Sugar Bowl Hall of Fame in 2019.

A native of Mobile, Ala., Dooley is married to the former Barbara Meshad of Birmingham. They have four children: Deanna (Mrs. Destry Rogers), Daniel (married to the former Suzanne Maher), Denise (Mrs. Jay Douglas Mitchell), and Derek (married to the former Allison Jeffers) who is currently an offensive analyst with Alabama. The Dooleys also have eleven grandchildren: Patrick Cook (married to Lauren Oyler), Catherine and Christopher Cook; Michael and Matthew Dooley (Daniel and Suzanne); Ty, Joe and Cal Mitchell; and John Taylor, Peyton, and Julianna Elizabeth Dooley (Derek and Allison Dooley). Three great grandchildren are the most recent additions from Patrick and Lauren: twins Murphy Elizabeth and Miles Marie born on Dec. 21, 2018, and one-year old Lane Catherine.

Robert Shane Kimbrough is a retired United States Army officer and NASA astronaut. He was part of the first group of candidates selected for NASA astronaut training following the Space Shuttle Columbia disaster. He is married to the former Robbie Lynn Nickels of Marietta, Georgia. They have three children. He enjoys baseball, golf, weightlifting and running.

Born June 4, 1967, in Killeen, Texas, he graduated from The Lovett School, Atlanta, Georgia, in 1985; received a Bachelor of Science degree in Aerospace Engineering from the United States Military Academy, West Point, New York, in 1989 and a Master of Science degree in Operations Research from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 1998.

He entered the U.S. Army Aviation School in 1989 and was designated an Army aviator in 1990. In late 1990, he was assigned to the 24th Infantry Division (Mechanized), Fort Stewart, Georgia, and was deployed to Southwest Asia, where he served in Operation Desert Storm. In 1994, he was assigned to the 229th Aviation Regiment (Attack) (Airborne) at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, where he commanded an Apache helicopter company as well as the Regimental headquarters company.

After completing a Masters of Science degree at the Georgia Institute of Technology in 1998, he was assigned as an assistant professor in the Department of Mathematical Sciences at the United States Military Academy

Kimbrough joined the NASA team at the Johnson Space Center (JSC) in September 2000. He was assigned to NASA's Aircraft Operations Division at Ellington Field in Houston, where he served as a Flight Simulation Engineer (FSE) on the Shuttle Training Aircraft (STA). Kimbrough was selected as an astronaut candidate by NASA in May 2004. In February 2006, he completed Astronaut Candidate Training.

STS-126 Endeavour (November 14 to November 30, 2008) launched at night from the Kennedy Space Center, Florida, and returned to Edwards Air Force Base, California. It was NASA's 4th shuttle flight in 2008 and the 27th shuttle/station assembly mission. Kimbrough launched on October 19, 2016, as part of Expedition 49/50. He became the Commander of the International Space Station a week after he reached the ISS and remained so until he departed almost six months later. During Expedition 50, Kimbrough performed four spacewalks, logging over 26 hours. This increased his total to six spacewalks and over 39 hours outside the orbiting laboratory. Kimbrough's third flight launched on April 23, 2021. He served as the Commander of the NASA/SpaceX Crew-2 mission to the ISS in the Crew Dragon spacecraft. Kimbrough performed three spacewalks on this flight bringing his total to nine and over 59 hours of time outside of the ISS. This flight lasted 199 days, completed 3,190 orbits of the Earth, and covered over 84 million miles. Kimbrough now has logged 388 days in space, and he became the fourth person to fly on three different spacecraft.

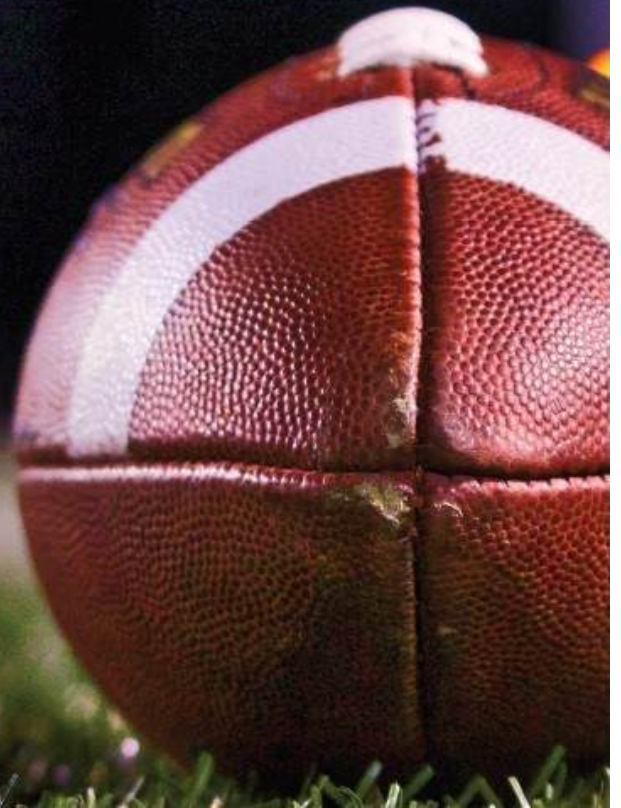



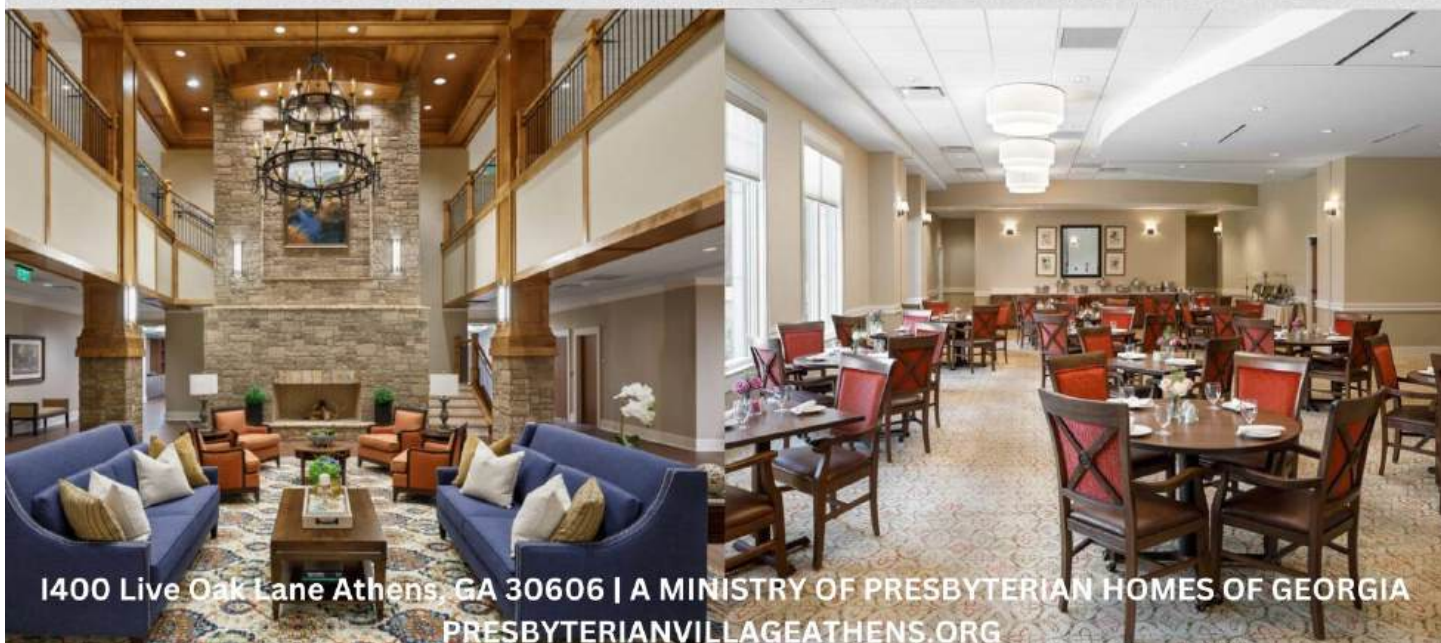
